Services: In Home Supportive Services (IHSS) is a federal, state, and locally funded program designed to provide assistance to disabled, blind, or age 65 or older (children potentially eligible) who, without this care, would be unable to remain safely in their own homes, and would be at risk of being placed in a care facility. IHSS is considered an alternative to out-of-home care, such as nursing homes or board and care facilities.

Some services that can be authorized through IHSS include: housecleaning, meal preparation, laundry, grocery shopping, personal care services, accompaniment to medical appointments, and protective supervision for the mentally impaired.

It provides personal support and services to provide more intensive care that is available through home care services. Assisted living typically offers assistance with the activities of daily living and ensures residents have access to staff 24 hours a day. It's also less expensive and less restrictive than a nursing home. The Assisted Living Waiver (ALW) program is one long-term care option for Medi-Cal recipients, and offers an alternative to nursing facility placement. The program is a combination federal/state funded program that allows eligible individuals to reside in and receive services from a California licensed Residential Care Facility.
