Program Qualifiers	Payment Description
Quality Measure total rate result for assigned members is less than 25th percentile	No incentive payment for the measure
Quality Measure total rate result for all assigned members meets 25th percentile but less than 33rd percentile	Payment of 30% of the total budgeted amount for the measure
Quality Measure total rate result for all assigned members meets 33rd percentile but less than 50th percentile	Payment of 60% of the total budgeted amount for the measure
Quality Measure total rate result for all assigned members meets 50th percentile but less than 66th percentile	Payment of 100% of the total budgeted amount for the measure
Quality Measure total rate result for all assigned members meets or surpasses 66th percentile	Payment of additional \$10,000 for the measure (up to 10 measures total)

The total amount available for each measure is determined by the average number of assigned members during the calendar year and the level of achievement reached.

Performance Improvement — Additional incentives can be earned for up to 10 measures that improved at least 3 to 5 percentile points compared to Calendar Year 2023 in the following domains:

- Children’s and behavioral health measures: 3 percentile points or more
- All other measures: 5 percentile points or more
